

The CACHS Current



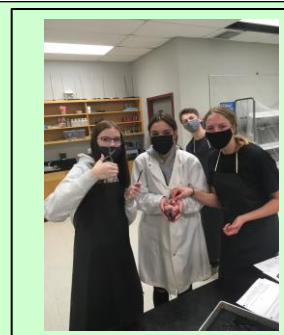
