

Principal's Ponderings: Partners in Education

During our October Board meeting I asked our Board members to reflect on our Education Plan Goal #4: Engagement and Improvement. While reflecting, a Board member asked me about our educational partners. The context of Goal #4 is "Central Alberta Christian High School is committed to ongoing communication and engagement with educational partners to improve decision-making and assurance." Since this short conversation at the Board meeting, I have considered the incredible educational partners CACHS is blessed with. It would be difficult to mention and celebrate all of our educational partners, but in October some have stood out.

Building Blocks Thrift Store has been a wonderful CACHS supporter for many years. Just this past month Building Blocks donated \$150,000 (!!) to CACHS. Many parents, grandparents, friends, and relatives of our students have spent thousands of hours volunteering at Building Blocks to sort donations, stock shelves, fold clothes, run the till,

sit in meetings, etc. These people have ensured that Building Blocks continues as an integral supporter of independent Christian education in Lacombe.

Also in October I attended conferences held by the Prairie Centre for Christian Education (PCCE) and Alberta Independent Schools and Colleges Association (AISCA). At the PCCE Teachers' Convention our teaching staff was blessed to spend two days in Taber going through Christian worldview professional development with about 450 like-minded Christian educators. Accordingly, while at the AISCA convention I met principals representing 34,000 students. If AISCA were a school district it would be the fifth largest in Alberta! On their own neither PCCE or AISCA fill all our needs, but together they provide excellent support for our school (i.e., government lobbying, professional development, school governance, policy development, government compliance, HR advice, etc.). Both PCCE and AISCA are instrumental to the existence of CACHS.

When we consider the greater Central Alberta community, another event with educational partners was our home volleyball tournament held in October. It was a great success with the bleachers full at both gyms – LCHS and CACHS – throughout the weekend. We are very blessed with our relationship with our local public high school, and we aim to continue as such for the benefit of the larger community. Furthermore, it was great seeing hundreds of family members, friends and alumni cheering on our student-athletes, coaches and our competition. Home athletics tournaments are wonderful events allowing us to spend time with our community.

There are many other partners that continue to sustain CACHS, and I speak for our staff and students by saying thank-you for your faithful support of independent Christian education in Central Alberta!
